Preparation of parishioners to give the Eucharist	Vincenzo		5'	Vincenzo suggested training a few Eucharistic ministers to visit people at home to bring the Eucharist to those who are sick or shut-ins, to support Father. But Peter pointed out that for now, the rule remains in place that only the priest can distribute the Eucharist. So how does that apply to bringing communion to shut-ins? Elda suggested we ask the Ste Anne's parish 'visiteurs des malades' to see how they do it. Father noted that we should find out first if there is a need. Father has on one occasion gone to give the sacrament of the sick to a parishioner in hospital. We will discuss this again to decide if we put it in place next school year.
